MINUTES LOWRY COMMUNITY MASTER ASSOCIATION, INC. VIRTUAL BUDGET RATIFICATION MEETING December 3, 2020

WELCOME & INTRODUCTIONS

CALL TO ORDER

ROLL CALL

Although quorum is not required by Colorado law for the Budget Ratification meeting, there were 40 units represented out of 4,077, representing approximately 1% of the units.

PURPOSE OF MEETING

The purpose of the meeting was to ratify the budget.

PROOF OF NOTICE

Joel Malecka announced the notice of the meeting was given in accordance with Colorado law and the Association's governing documents.

BUDGET RATIFICATION

The 2021 budget was provided to all owners in advance of the annual meeting in accordance with Colorado law.

Joel Malecka announced that, according to Colorado law, the 2021 budget is deemed approved by the owners unless a majority of all members veto the budget at the meeting. Because only approximately 1% of the owners were in attendance, the budget could not be vetoed by a majority of all of the owners, and was deemed ratified.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion to adjourn was made by Jessie Johnson and seconded by Jane Wilson. There being no objections, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:12 pm.
